

Specification for Grading Block No. 179, in the
City of Portland.

On the East and West sides of the Block to be graded to level parallel lines, the West side $5\frac{9}{10}$ feet above the Front or east side and the surface throughout the block to be made to conform to this grade, fair and uniform, except around the School House which is to be terraced 12 ft. wide, 18 inches above and parallel to the grade adjoining the foundation walls, and made to slope sufficient to leave a margin 6 inches high at the outside and also if required by the school directors, a similar terrace 10 ft. wide to be filled around the well House, and also a similar terrace 6 ft. wide around the spring. Around the four sides of the Block to be grade a side walk 9 ft. wide to conform to the grade lines of the Block with of four inches to the outer edge, in filling for the side walks sufficient slope to be made to leave the full breadth at the top, and in cutting, a trench to be cut 12 inches wide and 6 inches deep ~~out~~ side of the walk, to conduct the water.

All cutting to be done to the line of grade and all filling to be made above the grades in the proportion of 2 inches to 1 foot filling, ⁽²⁾ into ~~2~~ ft. filling 4 inches to 3 ft. filling, ~~&c.~~ It is estimated there is sufficient earth to cut and fill, equally, and if a small amount of surplus should exist it is to be spread on the Block as the School Directors shall order,
